## Programme Overview & Objectives

This is a 1-year Masters programme that runs for two (2) semesters on full-time basis and four (4) semesters for part-time.

There are two streams for the programme:

- **Weekday Stream** – Lectures are held from Mondays – Fridays
- **Weekend Stream** – For working students who want to combine the programme and work. Lectures are held on Thursday and Friday evenings and Saturdays.

The programme aims to equip students with the necessary skills to make a meaningful contribution to policy formulation and implementation in this field. The programme is designed to provide:

- Broad knowledge on the concepts and skills related to finance in developing and emerging markets.
- Knowledge and skills in financing the design and implementation of development projects.
- Good appreciation of current issues on development finance, both at the macro and micro levels in developing and emerging economies.
- Appreciation of the challenges with respect to development finance in developing and emerging economies.
- Provide the platform for postgraduate research in the area of development finance in developing and emerging economies.

## Lecture Periods

Lectures are held from:

1. Monday to Friday at 7:30am - 5:00pm. (Weekday Stream)
2. Thursdays – Fridays at 6:00pm – 8:30pm and Saturdays 7:30am – 6:30pm (Weekend Stream)

## Admission Requirements

The admission requirement for the programme is a good first degree (at least 2nd class lower division) and 2 years work experience in a related field or any other degree from a recognized university.

An equivalent professional qualification, with at least five (5) years relevant work experience in executive positions.

\*Applications for admission into this programme are opened from January and closes in March every year.
